

GUIDELINES FOR A ONE TIME REBATE DISTRIBUTION WITH A 50/50 SPLIT

For orders placed from April 2017 through March 2018, those families opting to apply 50% of the rebate money to the Redeemer School Annual Fund *and* 50% of the rebate money to Redeemer School fees and tuition, the **fees and tuition portion** of the distribution will be made in the following order:

- (1) The rebate will be applied to any outstanding tuition and/or fees due from previous months.
- (2) The rebate will be applied to the family's activity fees for the 2018-2019 school year, which is due May 1, 2018.
- (3) If a family chooses not to use the rebate to pay their 2018-2019 Activity Fees, the unused rebate will be donated to the Annual Fund in addition to the 50% already given.

If a family will *not* be returning to Redeemer School the 2018-2019 school year, rebates will be distributed in the following order:

- (1) The rebate will be applied to any outstanding tuition and/or fees due from previous months.
- (2) The rebate will be applied to the final tuition payment in May 2018.
- (3) Any remaining rebate will be applied to the 2017-2018 Annual Fund in addition to the 50% already given.

All rebates earned from orders placed from April 2018 through March 2019 will be applied as above for the 2019-2020 school year.

Scrip orders will be placed once a month during June, July and August.

If a family leaves Redeemer School *during* the 2017-2018 school year, all rebates will be forfeited to the 2017-2018 Redeemer School Annual Fund.
